

Discovery Camps 2016

During the summer, for one week each month, Raven Hill Discovery Center will be offering special camps for kids ages 4 –14. Morning sessions are from 10am—12pm, and afternoon sessions are from 12:30—2:30, or come for the whole day! Museum play time is available before and after sessions; please bring a bag lunch for full day camp. Each week, there will be one theme for morning sessions and a different theme for afternoon sessions. Students will have the opportunity to explore science, art, and history with hands-on activities, and will often come home with different creations. The reverse side shows what the topic will be each day to help you decide if you would like to come for a session, a whole day or the whole week. Activities for each day will be age-appropriate.

Full day, 5 days: \$125

Individual full days: \$30/day

Half Day, 5 days: \$85

Individual half days: \$20/day

Includes admission to the museum during camp days. Full day participants will need to bring a lunch.
